

## **Welcome to 'MEM CHECK'**

As a newcomer to Visual Basic and the Windows API I hope that this program will prove some use to you. It has certainly proved a learning experience for me.

Two non Microsoft DLLs' have been used and the authors are acknowledged within the program. DISKDLL.DLL was written by Neil J. Rubenking from the US PC Magazine with the APIGUIDE.DLL coming from another Ziff Davis publication - Visual Basic Programmers Guide to the Windows API by Daniel Appleman (ISBN 1-56276-073-4). I strongly recommend this book.

## **INSTALLATION**

### **DOWNLOADED**

To be reading this document you have obviously unzipped 'MEMK.ZIP'. I apologise for the absence of a windows style setup program, but I felt that to do so would enlarge the download program to the detriment of your phone bill !!

To install this program;

- 1] From the DOS prompt change to the directory that you have unzipped memk.zip  
(eg cd c:\downld <enter>)
- 2] Type - memk.bat <enter>. This batch file assumes you wish to place this program on your C drive. Any variations will require that the files are moved manually.
- 3] This bat file creates a directory 'MEMCHK' and moves the following files to it;

MEMCHK.EXE  
MEMCHK.HLP  
MEMCHK.WRI

The following files are moved to your c:\windows\system directory;

APIGUIDE.DLL  
DISKDLL.DLL

- 4] To create an icon for the program  
Open Windows  
Activate the Group you wish the icon to be placed within  
Select 'File - New' from the program manager menu.  
Select 'Program Item' .  
Description = MEMCHK  
Command Line = C:\MEMCHK\MEMCHK.EXE  
Working Directory = C:\MEMCHK

5] You will also need the file VBRUN300.DLL in your c:\windows\system directory, which can be downloaded from CIS.

### **DISK BASED**

If you obtained MEM CHECK from a shareware supplier;

Open windows and select setup.exe from the disk and all will be done!!
