

#1\$2K3 The Toolbar

The Toolbar is a row of buttons at the top of the main window which represent application commands. Clicking one of the buttons is a quick alternative to choosing a command from the menu. Buttons on the toolbar activate and deactivate according to the state of the application. The toolbar itself may be moved with the mouse and left as a floating palette, or docked to any edge of the main window.
