Enabling Sound capabilities on your system may involve loading a sound driver for your particular sound hardware board installed.

If your system has only a speaker, you may enable sounds by the following:

1. Copy the file SPEAKER.DRV to your windows directory.
2. Edit your SYSTEM.INI file and find the section for [drivers] and place a new line with the following contents:
 wave=speaker.drv
3. You may now load Windows and choose the Control Panel|Drivers icon and select the setup button to install the speaker driver.
