1.2 What the heck did I just download?

What the heck did I just download?

MagicWB1.3 is a program which changes OS1.3 from 2 bitplanes (4 colors) to 3
bitplanes (8 colors) with the MagicWB palette preset so that you can use
Magic Workbench © by Martin Huttenloher on your A500 or A1000!!

This archive also includes the program PCheck which allows you to verify the

current number of bitplanes. This program can be used for any purpose and not just to confirm that MagicWB1.3 is running.

IconFix1.3 and IconUnfix1.3 are small icon fixing utils which will make your icons look like OS2+ icons.

Template is just a template pic which I got from another archive and have been adding stuff to it as needed. The template drawer which I added to the image has a dotted line around it to show where you need to cut it out for it to work properly (cut just inside of the dotted line).

system-configuration is a pretty nice setup with a really nice mouse pointer which you can copy into your devs drawer (make sure you back yours up or rename it in case you don't like this one).

To enhance your MagicWB, look for MagicWBStuff3.lha on aminet in pix/icon! This archive by Trevor Morris contains lots of pix, icons, and imagedrawers to go with your MagicWB1.3!

Also grab up RomIcons1.lha through RomIcons7.lha created by Roman Patzner on any Aminet site in pix/icon for the best looking icons created for MagicWB!

If you are not familiar with MagicWB, see the included Example.pic.

1.4 How do I get MagicWB1.3 running?

MagicWB1.3

Couldn't be simpler: just insert this command after the LOADWB command and before the ENDCLI command in your startup-sequence. Now reboot the machine and presto!

For example:

```
C:BlahBlah
.
.
.
LoadWB
```

C:MagicWB1.3  
EndCLI
```

1.5 How do I get PCheck running?

PCheck

This one is even simpler: just open a CLI and type the command! That is it, and PCheck will return the current screen name and tell you how many bitplanes it is using.

For example:

```
9.System1.3:> df0:c/pcheck  
Workbench has 3 bitplanes
```

1.6 What do I do with the Pictures?

Example.pic

Example.pic is just a snapshot of my WorkBench. You may show it with your favorite viewer, or load it into DPaint.

Template.pic

The Template.pic is for making your own icons (use it in DPaint). Or, you could download some VERY NICE premade ones by Trevor Morris and Roman Patzner.

1.7 How do I get IconFix1.3 running?

IconFix1.3

Since OS2+ automatically adds a bevel to each icon, the ones you make using the template will still look strange, as will the ones you download from Trevor Morris and Roman Patzner...so you need IconFix1.3 and IconUnfix1.3!

IconFix1.3 will add the extra bevel to your icons for you automatically!! All you have to do is specify the icon's name WITHOUT the ".info"

For example:

```
10.System1.3:> c:iconfix1.3 df0:utils/SID
```

This will add the bevelled edge to the SID icon "SID.info"

1.8 How do I get IconUnfix1.3 running?

IconUnfix1.3

IconUnfix1.3 is just the opposite of IconFix1.3, meaning that it will remove the extra bevel on your icons (ie it will reverse the effects of IconFix1.3) Just specify the icon's name WITHOUT the ".info"

For example:

```
11.System1.3:> c:iconunfix1.3 df0:utils/SID
```

This will remove the bevelled edge from the SID icon "SID.info"

The graphics and this guide file were done by Trevor Morris on the same A3000 using OpalVision, Art Department Professional and Deluxe Paint.
