The Grammar of Ornament

Owen Jones' *Grammar of Ornament* is one of the most famous and sought after works on Ornamental Design ever published. This monumental work was produced on over 600 hand etched stone plates and took 5 artisans nearly a year to complete. Many of its designs were taken from ancient monuments and buildings that are no longer extant. The *Grammar of Ornament* had a profound influence on the development of the Arts and Crafts Movement and on the designs of artists such as William Morris and Louis Sullivan.

Direct Imagination is pleased to offer the complete *Grammar of Ornament* on computer CD-ROM in two versions: the *Professional Artists' Edition* and the *Compact Edition*. These beautiful reproductions are taken from lithographs printed with the original stone plates. They contain 20 chapters of live text and 112 full color plates.

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Description

The *Grammar of Ornament, Professional Artists' Edition*, contains three complete works: It includes all of the artwork from the Quarto edition, plus full resolution scans of all 2,300 original Folio designs, featuring delicate detail that could not be rendered in the smaller Quarto format. The complete text has been reproduced in Postscript and is hyper-linked with the art, allowing the user to move seamlessly between the text and art with the click of a mouse. And finally, 160 selected designs have been redrawn with Adobe Illustrator as EPS (ALiveArt!©).

On-line help is available, as well as an extensive User Manual for installation and operation of the CD-ROM. A printed color pictorial guide to all 2,300 designs is also included for easy reference.

The *Grammar of Ornament* is also available as a more economical *Compact Edition*. It has all the same features as the professional edition, but omits the high resolution details and the ALiveArt! of the Professional Artists' Edition. It is designed for student use and as a coffee table book. (It has samples of selected details and ALiveArt! designs).

All *Grammar of Ornament* Illustrations may be reproduced without licensing fees or copyright restrictions.

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ALive Art!

ALiveArt!* is a collection of royalty-free Postscript designs from the *Grammar of Ornament*, intended for Artists, Industrial designers, and Desktop Publishers. ALiveArt! patterns are ready to use and can be easily modified or scaled to any size without loss of quality. Color designs may also be printed as 4 color separations without requiring custom colors. Direct Imagination's artists did not simply trace the designs. Each one was analyzed for the thought process that created the original work - for the symmetries inherent in it. Every edge lines up perfectly with its neighbors and symmetrical designs tile perfectly. There are no multiple layers to complicate your work or interfere with trapping and no reliance on clumsy line strokes or overlaps to cover up imperfect edges.

Included on the *Professional Edition's* CD-ROM are 160 of the best designs. Each is reproduced in 4 formats: Color, Gray scale, Black & White, and Line Drawing, yielding 640 different possibilities. Changing the color, scale, and juxtaposition of these can produce boundless additional variations. ALiveArt! designs have been grouped into 6 categories:

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Implementation and System Requirements

The *Grammar of Ornament* is implemented using Adobe Acrobat version 2.1. Acrobat provides the user with the ability to copy both text and illustrations into other documents, with high quality Postscript text, word search, and continuous magnification. A copy of the Acrobat reader is included on each CD-ROM.

The *Grammar of Ornament* will operate on any of the following computer systems:

Macintosh: Macintosh II (68040) or Power Mac:

- At least 4MB of application RAM, 8 or more is recommended (16MB Total).
- System 7.0 or later
- CD ROM Drive

IBM PC: IBM PC or compatible (486 or Pentium):

- At least 4MB of RAM
- Windows 3.1, 95, or NT 3.5

- CD ROM Drive

Display: The Grammar of Ornament can be used on systems with 16 or 24 bit color controllers. 17 inch monitors, or larger, are recommended. 8-bit display controllers are not recommended.

Software: Photoshop and either Illustrator or Free-hand are strongly recommended.

Both editions of the *Grammar of Ornament* are sold in a box that is a faithful reproduction of the 1856 Folio Book. Permanent, practical, and handsome, its leather textured cover is stamped in gold leaf foil with the original designs. The book opens up to reveal storage compartments for both the manuals and the CD-ROM, which is in a jewel case. The book makes an elegant, eye catching display and also ends the lament of many Multimedia purchasers, who can never seem to keep the pieces of a product together, once the cardboard box has been discarded. The box is secured with tamper-detection closures, and is shrink-wrapped with a colorful back-panel description of the product.

HELP: Mouse



Here is the normal mouse cursor.

If you click the mouse now, you will jump to a new location.



When you move it over an active area, its shape changes to a pointing finger.

TRY IT!



This cursor magnifies. Normal image data is stored at 72 DPI, but image details (pg. 8) can be magnified up to 300% for better resolution. ALive Art! is EPS and can be magnified up to 800%. Text may also be enlarged up to 800%.



This cursor, located under Tools, above, is the graphics selection tool. Use it to draw a rectangular marquee around an image. Then use Control-c to copy the data. Control-v to place it into another application.
