Introduction

OpenList is a Windows program that will show you information on what files are currently open on your Windows 95 or 98 system. The information includes the file's path, the way the file has been opened file, and the share and access modes of the open.

OpenList works on Windows 95 and Windows 98.

Using OpenList

When you start *OpenList* it will enumerate all open files. The display can be refreshed with the F5 hot-key or the Refresh toolbar button. Finally, *OpenList*'s output window can be saved to a file using the Save functionality.
