

Welcome to *WinCIS Charges* ! This program calculates and displays general and detailed information about Compuserve calls, connect time, and charges from WinCIS log files.

- > At startup, calls, connect time and charges are calculated and displayed for the current month.
- > Information can be calculated for specific months or years.
- > For incomplete time periods, projected charges are also calculated and displayed.
 - > Information can be saved to formatted text files, or exported to comma-delimited text files for import by spreadsheet or database programs.

Requirements

To run *WinCIS Charges* you must have the files in CHARG1.ZIP and CHARG2.ZIP, plus threed.vbx and vbrun200.dll. CHARG1.ZIP and CHARG2.ZIP are in library 12 of the WUGNET forum on Compuserve. The other two files (threed.vbx and vbrun200.dll) are already installed on your system if you are running WinCIS. If you own VB2 Professional Edition, then you already have the files in CHARG2.ZIP, and you only need to download CHARG1.ZIP. If you do not own VB2 Professional Edition, then you must download both zip files. The contents of the two files are listed below.

Contents of CHARG1.ZIP:

readme1.wri.....This file.
wccharge.exe.....*WinCIS Charges* executable.
wccharge.hlp.....*WinCIS Charges* help file.

Contents of CHARG2.ZIP:

readme2.wri.....Copy of this file.
cmdialog.vbx.....Common dialog box custom control.
commdlg.dll.....Common dialog box dll.
graph.vbx.....Graph custom control.
grid.vbx.....Grid custom control.
gsw.exe.....Graphics server.
gswdll.dll.....Graph dll.

Installation and Setup

The program file and help file, wccharge.exe and wccharge.hlp, must be in the same directory on your hard drive. Copy the files in CHARG2.ZIP (except readme2.wri) to your windows\system directory. (Don't forget that you must also have threed.vbx and vbrun200.dll in your windows\system directory.) That's it! The first time you run *WinCIS Charges* you will be asked to enter your WinCIS directory. The program will then create a configuration file, wccharge.ini, in your windows directory. Consult online help for a complete description of *WinCIS Charges*.
