TheLister

Introduction

.....

.

TheLister is an advanced listing utility for Pascal programs. Its clean graphic layout greatly enhances the readability of your listings, allowing you to indentify at a glance the most important parts in a program.

Each page is numbered and marked with a date/time stamp, so it's easier to distinguish the different versions of the same file.

Moreover **TheLister** is easily customizable to fit your needs and your taste.

Important: Read the **README.TXT** file for last minute information.

Starting TheLister

When you run an unregistered copy of **TheLister** a dialog box pops up on the screen showing basic information on the application. This Dialog box contains two push buttons: the **Ok** button and the **Register** button.

You can push the **Ok** button to go on (during the evaluation period), or the **Register** button if you have the registration code and you want to register the application (see the **Registration** chapter for more details).

After a while the main window appears on the screen. In the lower band you'll see four buttons:

1. **File Open (File cabinet icon):** choose the file to list.
2. **Print (Printer icon):** print the selected file
3. **Setup (Tool set icon):** customize **TheLister**.
4. **Exit (Door icon):** exit the application.

Selecting a file

If you click on the **File** button - the file cabinet icon - you get the usual **File Open** dialog.

From this dialog you can change drives, browse through directories and select the Pascal file you want to list.

Once you have selected the file, double clicking on it or pressing the **Ok** button, its name appears in the lower band of the window.

Listing the file

Clicking on the **Printer** button - the printer icon - you can print the selected file

.

If no file has been selected a warning dialog appears on the screen otherwise **TheLister** displays the print dialog.

This dialog box shows the number of pages that would be printed and allows you to choose if you want to list all the file or a limited range of pages. It also prompts you for the number of copies, 1 being the default.

Clicking the **Ok** button a status dialog appears while the selected file is being printed.

An **Abort** button allows you to quit the printing process.

On each page you'll find the path and the name of the file, the page number and the date and time of printing.

The Pascal reserved words are printed with a different typographic style, the comments are italicized and the procedure headers can be easily identified since they have a border around them.

All these typographic effects can be easiliy customized as described in the next chapter.

Customizing TheLister

A click on the **Setup** button - the tool set icon - opens the **Preferences** dialog box which allows you to customize **TheLister**.

Let's analyze it section by section:

General

Font: This combo box allows you to select the font that will be used for the listing. It shows all the TrueType fixed pitch fonts present in the system. (Windows 3.1 comes with only one font of this type, Courier New).

Lines per inch: you can decide how many lines of code will be placed in every page specifying the number of lines per inch in this control. The default is 6, but you can get good results also using 7 or 8 lines per inch.

Tab size: allows TheLister to properly expand tabs. This value should be the same you put in your editor.

Date and time formats: these two combo boxes allow you to chose the format of the date/time string that's printed in the footer of each page. Try the different options looking at the example displayed in the lower right corner of this section to preview the final result. The date and time separators are taken from the **[Intl]** section in your **WIN.INI** file.

Double side printing: if this option is checked the headers and the footers of odd and even pages will have a simmetrical layout.

Use common dialogs: if this option is checked Windows 3.1 File Open common dialog will be used in place of Borland standard dialog.

Reserved words and Comments

Reserved words: this group of check boxes allows you to customize the appearance of Pascal reserved words in the printout. The default is **Bold** but you could as well decide that having them underlined improves the readability. The best thing is, as usual, to experiment. More than one option can be checked at the same time.

Comments: by checking the **Italic** option all the comments in the file will be italicized.

Headers, sections and procedures

TheLister enhances the appearance of the main elements in a program file. These elements are grouped in three classes:

Headers: the **program**, **library** and **unit** statements.

Sections: the **interface** and **implementation** statements.

Procedures: the headers of **procedures**, **functions**, **constructors** and **destructors**.

You can customize the appearance of these special lines by enclosing them in a frame and/or shading them.

Frame type: a group of 4 check boxes lets you decide which sides of the frame will be printed.

Width: the width of the border.

Shading: this edit control allows you to specify the intensity of the shading. This is a number ranging from 0 (black) to 255 (white, that is no shading). I strongly recommend you to use values in the 192..255 range, lower values give very dark shadings and the content of the line is unreadable.

Buttons

On the bottom of the dialog box there are four buttons:

The first two are the usual **Ok** and **Cancel** buttons

The third one, named **Setup**, allows you to select a printer and to set up the printer driver

The last one, the **Info** button, shows you the dialog that appears at the beginning of the application and again allows you to register.

Closing the application

.....

If you want to exit, simply press the **Exit** button - the door icon - and **TheLister** will prompt you for a confirm. If you press the **Yes** button the application terminates.

TheLister

Registration

TheLister is a **Shareware** program: this means that you may use it for evaluation purposes for up to 30 days. If at the end of this period you decide that you want to continue to use the program you must register it.

The registration fee for **TheLister** is **\$20.00**.

To register you can choose among one of the following ways.

PsL will send you the latest available version of **TheLister** together with your registration code. The shipping and handling charge is **\$ 4.00 (\$ 6.00 overseas)**.

CompuServe Shareware Registration Service

You can register on-line using **CompuServe Shareware Registration DataBase**. Type **GO SWREG** and follow the instructions on the screen.

The registration ID for this program is **1412**.
