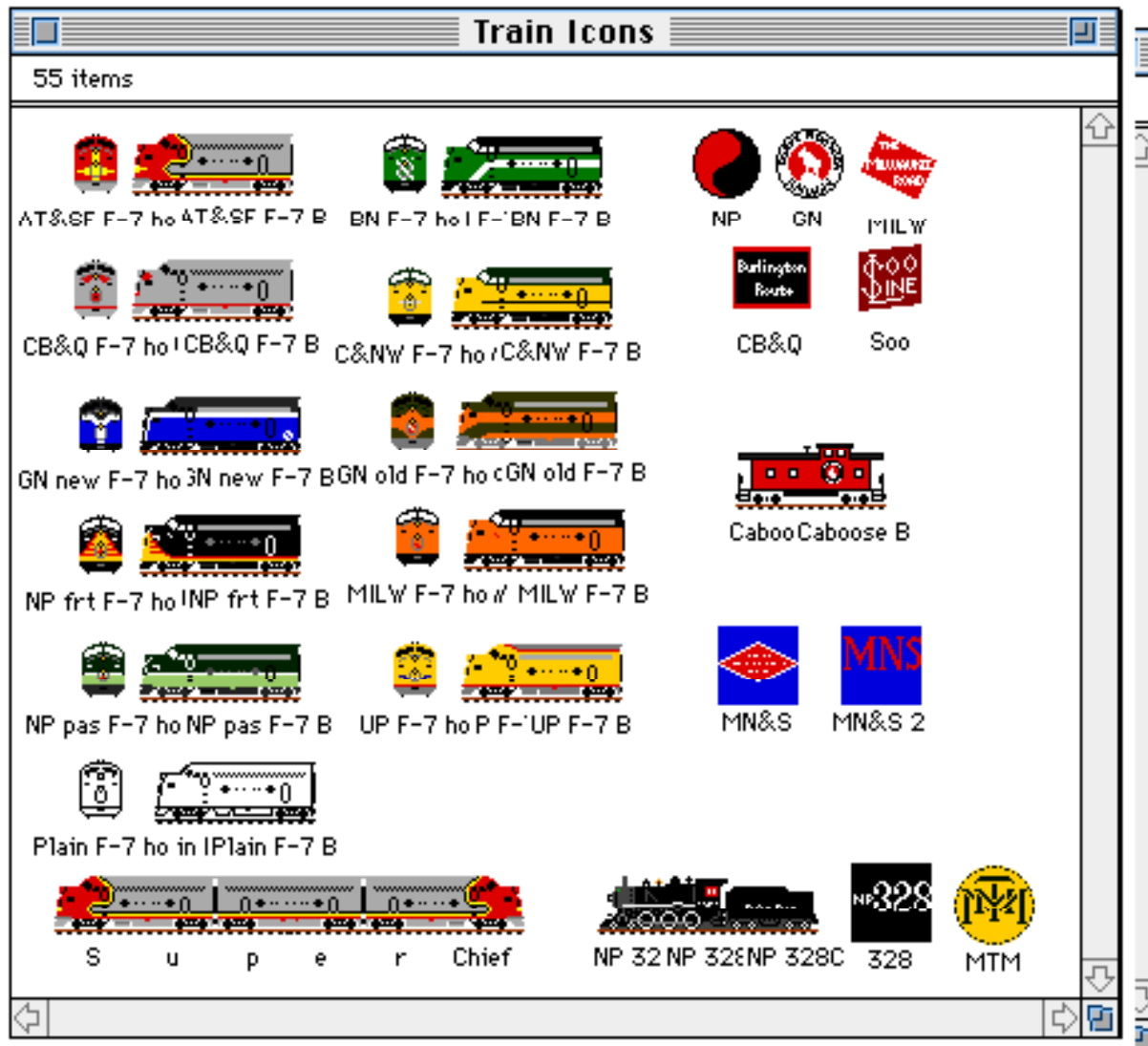


Rail Icons 1.0

What you should see:

They mean what they say when they say things like, "Contents may settle during shipping". In other words, the icons might be all jumbled by the time you see them. With a little bit of fine tuning and a steady hand, you can put things right. Just follow this simple road map:



How to use the icons:

You can attach these icons to your folders, disks, etc., and make your desktop a better place to live. To copy an icon:

- 1) select an icon,

- 2) "Get Info" (in the "File" menu of the finder),
- 3) select the icon in the info window,
- 4) "Copy" (in the "Edit" menu of the finder),
- 5) select destination folder, disk, etc.
- 6) "Get Info"
- 7) select the icon in the upper left hand corner of the info window
- 8) "Paste" (in the "Edit" menu)

Now for the "asking for money" bit, AKA, this is shareware:

You are free to use (play with, throw at the cat, etc.) these icons for one week after receiving it. If you like it and decide to keep it, you should send a \$5 "shareware" fee to myself at the address below. Please include a brief note describing where you got this font, what you like about it, and what you would like to see added to it.

If you just have to have the full collection of my train toys (my big thing is fonts, see below), send a FORMATTED 800k or HD disk and a self addressed stamped envelope to the address below. (I hate to format disks)

If you are honestly poor, (i.e., you ain't gonna support the American way and my education) please send a post card (the weirder the better) describing where you got this font, what you like about it and what you would like to see added to it.

You are free to distribute these icons, as long as you include this READ ME file with any icons you distribute.

If you have any train icons of your own, send them to me and I will include them in the next release of the collection. Also, if you have a favorite railroad that you would like to see an icon for, drop me a note and I will try to make it for you.

Now Showing:

If you like these icons, just wait 'till you see my railroad fonts. I have released two high resolution railroad picture fonts. For example, if you type "qaz" you get a locomotive-boxcar-caboose.



They are packaged as "Railroad Fonts" or individually as "Passenger Train Font" and "Freight Train Font".

I have also just released Modern Passenger Font, the son of Passenger Train font.

Coming soon:

Six new and different train fonts are currently on my drawing board.
