

umpster is a Control Panel Device that allows you to choose an alternative Trash can to replace the standard System 7 trash can.

IMPORTANT: If you are using ShareWare Dumpster version 1.0.b make sure you remove it from the Control Panels folder and also remove the "DumpsterCans" file from within the System Folder before installing "Dumpster" version 1.1.b.. The old "DumpsterCans" file is not compatible with Dumpster 1.1.b.

To install: drag the "Dumpster" file and the "DumpsterCans" file to the system folder, you will be prompted to install "Dumpster" into the control panels folder, click yes. The "DumpsterCans" file will be placed in the System Folder. That's it, open up your control panels folder and double click Dumpster.

To use Dumpster: Toggle through the various trash cans by clicking on the left or right arrow buttons in the Dumpster window or by pressing on the left and right arrow key's on your keyboard. Click on the "I" button or press the "I" on your keyboard to install the current trash can into the system. The first time you run Dumpster a "Dumpster Preference" file will be created within the Preference Folder and all preferences will be turned on. By selecting Preferences from the Dumpster menu or by pressing "P" on your keyboard you can change the various settings.

- 1) By checking the "Confirm before installing" Dumpster will display a confirmation dialog box before installing the current trash replacement into the system folder.
- 2) By checking the "Confirm before deleting" Dumpster will display a confirmation dialog box before deleting the current trash can from the DumpsterCans file.
- 3) By checking the "Install at startup" Dumpster will automatically install a new trash can at each startup. The ShareWare version will only install from the first five trash cans in the DumpsterCans file. With this checked enjoy a new trash can each time you start without even opening Dumpster.
- 4) By checking the "Show Ion at StartUp" Dumpster will display an icon at startup notifying you that Dumpster is installed.

By selecting "Delete" from the Dumspter menu you can delete the current trash can from the DumpsterCans file. By selecting "Revert" from the Dumspter menu you can

change back to the original System 7 trash cans.

EXTREMELY IMPORTANT:

Although Dumpster has gone through vigorous testing and the chance of a problem is very slim please always backup your system file before altering.

If you would like to get the registered version for free, create me five pairs of empty and full trash cans in the 'icl8' or 'cicn' resedit format. They must not be public domain and you must create them.

You can E-Mail me them at the E-Mail address below and I will examine them. If I like them I will include them with the registered version and I will send you a copy of the registered version of Dumpster.

The registered version of Dumpster comes with over 90 pairs of colorful replacement trash cans and allows you to automatically install from the whole DumpsterCans file. To obtain the registered version please send \$20.00 to:
