**NuFile** is a contextual menu plugin. It adds a new file menu when you right click at a folder(ie: desktop or Finder background). If you use this program frequently, please consider making a donation.

### **This package will install the following items:**

- NuFile.prefpane at /Library/PreferencePanes
- NuFile.plugin at /Library/Contextual Menu Items

**Warning: This package will restart the finder at the end of installation process.**

### **Feature:**

- Add the "New File" to the contextual menu.
  - Drag and Drop your own templates via the preference pane.
  - Open the file right after the creation(on by default. turn it off at the preference pane).
- And the program that will be used to open the new file is the same as the default program of the original template.
- Edit your templates from the preference pane

## **Version History**

### **Version 1.8**

- Bug Fix/Feature: Now the created file retains all file type and creator code. Plus all resource fork. That is what ever setting you have on the original template file (ex: default program to open that file) will get copied to the new file. (Requested by chleuasme and caught by Dan Frakes )
- Bug Fix: The author name of the default Microsoft Office documents is now blank. (Thanks Anon for his suggestions)
- Feature: Add an edit button. So that users can edit their template directly from the preference pane.(Requested by chleuasme)

### **Version 1.7**

- Feature: Add bundle resources support. Ex: Keynote , Pages etc.

### **Version 1.6**

- Bug Fix: blank preference pane in Panther and earlier version of OS X(Thanks nuffsad and Martink)

#### Version 1.5

- Feature: Add Drag and Drop in the preference. So, now it's much easier add a template. Just drag from Finder and drop it in the table.
- Feature: RTF is now in the default setting. If have older version and you want to use the new default setting you have to issue the following command at the terminal(without quotes and note that it's case-sensitive): 'default delete com.tee.NuFile'. All your preferences will be reset to the new Default.(As requested by Pete and an anonymous guest)
- Feature: Open file after creation. It's on by default. Turn it off at the preference pane. (As requested by Pete)
- Feature: Installer no longer requires log off. It'll restart Finder though.(As requested by Garoo)
