

Diablotin 1.2.8

Diablotin is a Preference pane which allows you to manage items in the Library folders.

If you're an user with administrative privileges, you can enable/disable these items.

Installation:

You can either:

- Drag the file Diablotin.prefPane to your **PreferencePanes** folder in the **Library** folder of your Home folder (you may need to create the **PreferencePanes** folder).

or

- Drag the file Diablotin.prefPane to the **PreferencePanes** folder in the **/Library** folder (you need to be an user with administrative privileges).

How does it work:

Open the System Preferences application. Diablotin should be listed in the 'Others' section at the bottom of the Main window. Click on it to display the Diablotin Interface.

Diablotin displays the list of Fonts, Internet Plug-ins, iTunes Plug-ins, QuickTime Plug-ins, ScreenSavers, Sounds and StartupItems that are not part of the Standard Mac OS X System Installation.

You can get more information on one of these items by selecting its line in the array.

The little checkbox in the array is showing the status (enabled/checked or disabled/unchecked) of the item.

You need to authenticate as an user with administrative privileges to enable/disable items. To do this, click on the Lock button at the bottom of the window.

To get information on the Families of items, just click on the name of the family.

FAQ:

Q: I'm not able to disable Diablotin Preference Pane and the Font Lucida Grande. Why?

A: The Diablotin Preference Pane is protected to avoid crashing the application when you're using it. The Lucida Grande Font is protected because it's the Mac OS X System Font.

Q: I'm not able to display the Pro W System Font in the Preview.

A: Yes this is currently not working.

How to fix problems due to the 1.1 move file bug:

- If one of your StartupItems was disabled/enabled in the case listed in the Version History, you can fix it this way:

- Create a new folder in the folder where your broken StartupItem lies

- Note the name of the Shell or binary (For instance with OpenBase, it's OpenBase)
- Move the files belonging to this StartupItem into the "*untitled folder*" folder
- Rename the "*untitled folder*" to the name you noted before

- If one of your ScreenSavers was disabled/enabled in the case listed in the Version History, you can fix it this way:

- Create a new folder in the folder where your broken StartupItem lies
- Inspect the Contents/Mac OS folder and note the name of the ScreenSaver
- Move the files belonging to this ScreenSaver into the "*untitled folder*" folder
- Rename the "*untitled folder*" to the name you noted before.
