

Use the **What's This** button on the properties dialog box.

Shows a sample of how the selected text will look with the current settings, in terms of text properties and colour. If no text is selected then the settings will affect what is typed next.

Lets you change the colour of the note "paper", by easily picking one from the available colour palette.

Lets you change the properties of the selected text easily by using the standard font selection dialog box.

Lets you choose one of a number of predefined note sizes (all calculated in proportion to the current screen resolution). Alternatively, you can resize the window as usual by dragging its border with the mouse.

Minimizes the window to the taskbar.

Tiny sized note window.

Small sized note window.

Medium sized note window.

Large sized note window.

The note window is maximised to full screen size.

Lets you change the caption of the note window.

Type the caption as you want it to appear on the title bar of the note window.

Positions the note window above every other window, even when it is not the active window.

This is the note itself. You can type onto this using the keyboard as usual. Right-click for its menu, and select an item. Use the properties option to change the appearance of the note, its contents and the note window.

Accepts all changes made to the properties and quits configuration.

Quits configuration, disregarding any changes made to the properties.

Makes all changes take effect so you can see them, without closing the properties dialog.
