## ***Tip Of The Day command (Help menu)***

Displays tips about using program features.

### **Did You Know?**

Displays a tip about using a program feature.

### **Show Tips At Startup**

Displays a tip every time you start the program. If you don't want to display tips when you start, clear this check box.

### **Next Tip**

Displays the next tip in the list.

### **More Tips**

Displays a list of tips available in this program.

## ***Tip Of The Day Contents (Tips Dialog)***

This Section is used to display all the tips which you have in your TOD INI file. Normally, you would build jumps to the help topic which provides in-depth information on the tip.

### **Registration & Purchase**

This is a trial version of TOD. You can purchase TOD by phone at (800) 818-1611. We accept Visa/MC and corporate POs.

You can add the EXE version of TOD (what you are using now) to your products for only \$19.95US, plus shipping and handling.

Source code for TOD is only an additional \$34.95US, plus shipping and handling. With source code you can modify TOD to suite your exact needs.

Buy both TOD and the source code at the same time for for just \$34.95US, save on shipping!

### **About TOD**

Use TOD to bring attention to documented, but perhaps underutilized features of your products.

You can have an unlimited number of tips if you purchase the source code, up to 25 tips when you resgister, and up to 10 tips otherwise.

You can customize TOD to programatically hide or show the 'More Tips...' and 'Help' buttons if you purchase the souce code.

To try TOD in your application, see the inlcuded DEMOTOD.MAK project.

Use Tips when users request features already in your products.

Tips can have unlimited characters per tip if you purchase the source code, up to 256 characters otherwise.

TOD is written in 100% Visual Basic, so when you purchase the source code you can easily build-it-in to your applications.
