

## AutoLoad for Visual Basic™

Thank you for trying out **AutoLoad for Visual Basic™**. I found it a pain in the kahobbies that VB opens up a new project at start up instead of automatically loading the last project. **AutoLoad** solves this, saving you some unnecessary mouse clicks and wasted time. More importantly, it also covers up that ugly, boring VB splash screen with one a lot more exciting.

So let's see... You should have three files:

1. README.WRI - this brilliant, full-featured, complete, and otherwise  
ROBA (read-once, blow-away) help file.
2. CTL3DV2.DLL - yet another DLL to toss into your \windows\system  
directory and forget. This enables a 3-D effect for any error message  
boxes. If you want to live in the dark ages of GUI design, you  
don't need to use it. All message boxes will simply have a boring  
white client area.
3. AUTOLOAD.EXE - a VB programs so incredibly complex and wonderous it  
defies description, or at least I'll spare you one. You can stick  
this little puppy in any directory, although the VB directory is a  
logical one.
