

The Registration Screen

The Registration screen is used to setup your Internet account. It is automatically displayed the first time you install Net Commander. To display the screen after installation, double-click the Registration icon in the Net Commander program group.

To setup your Internet account:

1. Enter the following information

Name	Enter your full name (First name, Last name) as you wish it shown on your billing statement.
Organization	Enter any applicable organization or company name.
Address	Enter your street address (e.g., 123 South Street).
Address 2	Use this field to enter an apartment number, suite number or Post Office box.
City	Enter your city.
State/Province	Enter your state (or province).
Zip/Postal Code	Enter your zip code (up to 5 characters).
Country	Enter the country in which you live (e.g., USA).
Credit Card Number	Enter a Visa or Master Card number including dashes to which you wish your account billed.
Visa/Master Card	Click the appropriate button for the credit card you are using to bill your account.
Expiration	Enter your credit card expiration date in MMY format (e.g., 1197).
Local Telephone Number	<p>Enter the telephone number for the line you will use to access the Internet. This may be your home or office number depending on where you are installing Net Commander. This field is used to determine your local POP number, so make sure you enter the correct (modem line) telephone number. Enter the entire telephone number, including area code (e.g., 512-555-1212).</p> <p>Enter the full telephone number, including area code (e.g., 512-555-1212).</p>
Office Telephone Number	Enter your office telephone, including area code (e.g., 512-555-1212).
Fax Number	Enter your fax telephone number, including area code (e.g., 512-1212).
Host Name: First Choice	<p>Enter a host name (user ID) using 3-6 characters that you would like to be known as when working on the Internet. The host name also acts as your E-mail address name and your login user ID.</p> <p>Host names must be unique or they will not be accepted. Use a name that has meaning to you. It is quite common to use your name, or a portion of your name as your host name. For example, if your name is Tom Jefferson you might use TJEFF as your host name.</p>
Host Name: Second Choice	Enter a second host name choice using 3-6 characters. This name will be used if your first choice has already been assigned to another Internet user.

2. After entering all the information on the registration dialog, click **Register** (Alt R) to create and register your new account.

Net Commander automatically establishes a link to the Internet provider (the default INP), establishes your Internet account, and creates your Host name and password. A message box displays showing you the steps Net Commander is executing as it proceeds through this process.

If you receive a message that a connection to the provider cannot be made, click OK to close the message and try again by clicking the **Register** (Alt R) button. This message simply means that the line to the provider was busy or that an error occurred in making the link. In most cases, you will be successful in establishing a link in your first or second attempt.

Advanced Screen

The Advanced screen is displayed whenever you click the Advanced button on the Registration screen. This screen is used to change your modem settings including the COM port, baud rate and modem setup.

To change your modem settings:

- 1 Enter the following information:

COM Port	Select the COM port to which your modem is attached. Press the arrow next to the field to display a drop-down list of available selections.
Baud rate	Enter your modems baud rate or press the arrow next to the field to display a drop-down list of available selections.
Modem	Press the arrow next to the field to display a drop-down list of available modems. Select your modem type from the list. If you do not see your modem, select Default Modem Settings .
Init String	Type ATZ .
Dialing Prefix	Enter any prefix you must use to access an outside line (for example, 9).

2. After making your entries, click OK. The Registration dialog re-displays.
3. To close the Registration dialog and apply any changes you have made, click **Cancel**.
