Overview: LogView

LogView enables you to easily review and print the latest set of log files produced by the Migration Tool for NetWare.

When you click **View Log Files** in the **Logging** dialog box in the Migration Tool, LogView automatically displays the current set of log files in three document windows.

LogView enables you to display additional files in separate document windows and to search through files.

To open a file

- 1 On the **File** menu, click **Open**.
- 2 Double-click the file you want to open.

You may need to locate the drive or folder that contains the file.

Working with LogView Windows

You can arrange the windows and icons representing each log file, using the following commands on the **Window** menu:

- To overlap windows so that each window title remains visible, click **Cascade**.
- To resize and arrange windows next to one another, click **Tile**.
- To arrange icons (minimized windows), click **Arrange**.

To print a log file

- ▶ Select the window containing the file, and then click **Print** on the **File** menu.

To search for text in a log file

- 1 Select the window containing the file you want to search.
- 2 On the **Search** menu, click **Find**.
- 3 In **Find What**, type the text you want to search for.
- 4 Select **Match Case** if you want a case-sensitive search.
- 5 Click **Down** or **Up** to set the direction of the search.
- 6 Click **Find Next** to start the search.

Tip

- You can easily repeat a search by clicking **Next** or **Previous** on the **Search** menu.

To close all files and their windows or icons

► On the **Window** menu, click **Close All**.

To quit LogView

- ▶ On the **File** menu, click **Exit**.

Log File Contents

Logfile.log provides a complete record of the migration, including both what was successfully transferred and what failed due to an error.

The file includes:

- **Transfer Options**

A record of the settings for user, group, and file transfer options.

**Supervisor Defaults**

A record of the defaults for the NetWare Supervisor account.

**Group Information**

A record of the NetWare groups migrated to Windows NT Server.

**User Information**








Account information (such as password and account restrictions) for each original NetWare account and each new Windows NT Server account.

**File Information**


A list of the folders copied and the number of files copied. You can also record a complete list of files copied.

Summary File Contents

Summary.log provides statistics for the conversion, including:

	Names of converted servers
	Total running time for the conversion
	Number of users transferred per server
	Number of groups transferred per server
	Number of files transferred per server
	Number of name conflicts
	Number of errors

Note

	The running time for a trial will be shorter than that for an actual migration, particularly when files are transferred.

Error File Contents

Error.log provides a list of any errors that occurred, including:



User names of accounts that were not transferred because of a name conflict.



Network errors, such as failure to access a server.



System errors, such as a lack of disk space for file transfers.

Open

Displays the **Open Text Files** dialog box, in which you can select files you want to open.

Print

Prints the log file displayed in the active window.

Printer Setup

Enables you to select a printer and set printer properties.

Exit

Quits LogView.

Next

For the log file in the active window, searches down through the file for the text specified in the **Find** dialog box.

Previous

For the log file in the active window, searches up through to file for the text specified in the **Find** dialog box.

Tile

Arranges open document windows side by side, so that all windows are visible.

Cascade

Arranges open document windows in an overlapping pattern so that the title bar of each window is visible.

Arrange Icons

Arranges all document window icons in rows.

Close All

Closes all open log files and clears their windows or icons from the LogView window.

List of Windows

The names of all open log files are listed at the bottom of the **Window** menu. You can click on a name to make that log file active.

Contents

Starts Help and displays the topics in help for LogView.

Search for Help on

Opens the **Index** tab for LogView Help, which you can use to look up Help information by using keywords.

How to Use Help

Describes how to use Help.





About LogView

Provides information about the LogView program.

Find

Searches for text in the log file displayed in the active window.

Find What

Type the text you want to search for.

Match Case

Select this to search for occurrences with the exact combination of uppercase and lowercase characters specified in **Find What**.

Find Next Button

Starts the search for the text shown in **Find What**.

Direction

Click **Up** to search up through the file for the text shown in **Find What**, or click **Down** to search down through the file for it.
