

Tell me about AudioEditor

Use TalkWorks AudioEditor to record and modify greetings, voice message and wave files. Create or modify files to be played to callers on hold and system notification wave files. Delete background noise and stretches of silence or change the order of segments of the wave file. Use special effects to create an echo or fade out.

FILE MENU

New command (File menu)

Creates a new wave (.WAV) file.

Open command (File menu)

Opens a wave (.WAV) file.

Save command (File menu)

Saves the loaded wave (.WAV) file.

Save As command (File menu)

Saves a new wave (.WAV) file or the loaded wave file under a new name.

Exit command (File menu)

Exits AudioEditor and returns to your Windows desktop.

EDIT MENU

Undo command (Edit menu)

Reverses the last editing change.

Cut command (Edit menu)

Deletes the selected segment from the wave file and places it on the Windows Clipboard.

Copy command (Edit menu)

Copies the selected segment and places it on the Windows Clipboard.

Paste command (Edit menu)

Pastes the contents of the Windows Clipboard into the wave file at the insertion point.

Paste From command (Edit menu)

Pastes a file into the loaded wave file at the current location of the cursor.

Delete command (Edit menu)

Deletes the selected segment from the wave file. Deleted segments are removed entirely and cannot be restored.

Select All command (Edit menu)

Selects the entire wave file.

Select Zoom command (Edit menu)

Toolbar command (View menu)

Toggles the display of the AudioEditor toolbar on and off.

Status Bar command (View menu)

Toggles the display of the AudioEditor status bar on and off.

Scale - Seconds command (View menu)

Scale - Samples command (View menu)

Zoom - None command (View menu)

Displays the wave file at 100% magnification in the lower audio panel for full detail. Use the scroll bars to view segments of the wave file not displayed in the lower audio panel.

Zoom - Close command (View menu)

Zoom - Out 2x command (View menu)

Zoom - In 2x command (View menu)

Zoom - To Selection command (View menu)

Volume Controls command (View menu)

Fade - In command (Effects menu)

Gradually increases the volume of the audio recording as it is being played.

Fade - Out command (Effects menu)

Gradually decreases the volume of the audio recording as it is being played.

Volume - Increase command (Effects menu)

Increases the volume of the audio recording.

Volume - Decrease command (Effects menu)

Decreases the volume of the audio recording.

Volume - Maximize command (Effects menu)

Maximizes the volume of the audio recording.

Volume - Mute command (Effects menu)

Silences all external noises at recording time.

Echo - Phone Booth command (Effects menu)

Adds an echo to the recording similar to the echo you hear in a phone booth.

Echo - Auditorium command (Effects menu)

Adds an echo to the recording similar to the echo you hear in an auditorium.

Echo - Music Hall command (Effects menu)

Adds an echo to the recording similar to the echo you hear in a music hall.

Echo - Arena command (Effects menu)

Adds an echo to the recording similar to the echo you hear in an arena.

Echo - Canyon command (Effects menu)

Adds an echo to the recording similar to the echo you hear in a canyon.

Speed - Increase command (Effects menu)

Increases the playback speed.

Speed - Decrease command (Effects menu)

Decreases the playback speed.

Trim Silence command (Effects menu)

Removes any periods of silence at the beginning and end of the audio recording.

Play command (Player menu)

Plays the loaded wave file.

Record command (Player menu)

Starts recording.

Pause command (Player menu)

Pauses playback.

Stop command (Player menu)

Stops recording.

Step Backward command (Player menu)

Moves the needle backwards in the wave file.

Step Forward command (Player menu)

Moves the needle forward in the wave file.

Rewind command (Player menu)

Rewinds the recording.

Fast Forward command (Player menu)

Fast forwards the recording.

Go To Beginning command (Player menu)

Repositions the needle at the beginning of the wave file.

Go To End command (Player menu)

Repositions the needle at the end of the wave file.

File Info command (Options menu)

Displays information about the loaded wave file.

Record Settings command (Options menu)

Sets settings for recording.

Tune Performance command (Options menu)

Always On Top command (Options menu)

Anchors the AudioEditor on the top of your desktop. If you open other programs, AudioEditor still remains in the foreground.

Auto Repeat command (Options menu)

Save Speed On Exit command (Options menu)

Enable Performance Alerts command (Options menu)

About command (Help menu)

Displays the product copyright notice, software version number, release date and your serial number. You will be asked to check this information if you contact Delrina Technical Support for assistance.
