

## **Mem Index**

The Index contains a list of all Help topics available for Mem. You can use the scroll bars to see the entries that are not currently visible in the Help window.

For information on how to use Help, press F1 or choose Using Help from the Help menu.

While viewing the Mem system menu, you may get context sensitive help by holding down the mouse button and pressing F1 while the item you want help on is selected. You may get context sensitive help from inside most of Mem's dialog boxes by selecting the "Help" button in the dialog box.

## **Preferences**

This will display a dialog box from which you may select to display the amount of memory free, the largest block of memory free, and/or the amount of disk space free on drives that you select.

Selecting "Commas" will insert commas as appropriate.

Selecting "In KB" will display all numbers in KB.

Selecting "Alarm when free memory is below" will cause Mem to sound an alarm if the amount of free memory goes below the number of bytes you specify in the edit box.

Mem will "remember" which options are selected so that the next time you run Mem, it will have the same options selected.
