

Introduction

Stereograms 2 converts monochrome bitmaps into random-dot stereograms, which can be viewed on-screen or printed.

A stereogram is a two dimensional graphic that appears three dimensional when viewed properly. Stereograms have been recently popularized by "The Magic Eye" and other books. Many newspapers include stereograms in their comics sections.

Required Hardware and Software

Windows 95, NT, or Win32s or later running on a '386, '486, or Pentium computer. A 16-bit version for Windows 3.1 is also available.

Installing Stereograms 2

Run `SETUP.EXE` from Windows.

Running Stereograms 2

After starting Stereograms 2, select the File menu and the Open submenu. Select a monochrome bitmap (.BMP) file. After the file has been loaded, it will be converted into a stereogram. The stereogram can then be viewed on the computer screen and printed.

Stereograms 2 comes with the following monochrome bitmap files: `AIRPLANE.BMP`, `CIRCLE.BMP`, `DIAMONDS.BMP`, `FLOWER.BMP`, `RING.BMP`, `SMILE.BMP`, and `STAR.BMP`.

For further instructions, select the Help menu and the Contents submenu.
