

### To play a CD

▶ Make sure the CD is in the CD-ROM drive, and then click ▶.

To stop playing your CD, click ■.

To eject your CD from the drive, click ▲.



### Tips

- If you want to specify individual tracks to play, you can create a [Play List](#).
- Your CD continues to play even if you minimize CD Player.

### To pause and resume a CD

- ▶ Click  to pause, and then click  to resume playing.

### To change to a different track

▶ Click  
 to move to the next track, or click  
 to move to the previous track.

### Tip

▪ To move forward or backward within a track, click  
 or  
.

**To play tracks in random order**

- ▶ On the Options menu, click Random Order.

**Tip**

- If you have more than one CD-ROM drive, you can use this feature to randomize each CD.

**To switch to a different CD**

- ▶ Click the arrow next to the Artist box, and then click the CD you want to play.

**Note**

- You must have more than one CD-ROM drive installed to change to another CD.

### **To play multiple discs**

- ▶ On the Options menu, click Multidisc Play.

#### **Note**



You must have a multidisc player to use this feature.

### To store the track titles of your CD

- 1 Make sure your CD is in the drive.
- 2 On the Disc menu, click Edit Play List.
- 3 Specify the artist's name and the title of your CD.
- 4 In the Available Tracks box, click the track whose name you want to store.
- 5 In the Track box, type the title of the track, and then click Set Name.

#### Tips



You can specify which tracks should be played and in which order by modifying the [Play List](#).



For Help on an item, click



at the top of the dialog box, and then click the item.

### To specify which tracks to play and in which order

- 1 Make sure your CD is in the drive.
- 2 On the Disc menu, click Edit Play List.
- 3 Specify the artist's name and the title of your CD.
- 4 In the Available Tracks box, click the track you want to add as the first track in your [Play List](#), and then click Add.
- 5 Repeat step 4 for each track you want to add to the Play List.

### Tips



To clear the default Play List, click Clear All.



To remove a track on the Play List, click the track, and then click Remove.




If you click Reset, the Play List matches contents of the Available Tracks box.




### **To customize CD Player**

 Click the View menu, and then click the settings you want.

### **Tips**

 To specify preferences, click the Options menu, and then click Preferences.

 For Help on an item, click  
 at the top of the dialog box, and then click the item.

### **To disable AutoPlay**

- 1 Double-click the My Computer icon.
- 2 On the View menu, click Options, and then click the File Types tab.
- 3 Click the AudioCD type, and then click Edit.
- 4 In the Actions list, click Play, and then click Set Default.

#### **Tip**



To temporarily disable AutoPlay, press the **SHIFT** key when inserting an audio CD.  
To reenale AutoPlay, repeat steps 1–4.

A Play List specifies which tracks of a CD to play and in which order. A Play List is useful if there are several songs on a CD that you like, but a few that you don't. Your Play List can specify that only the songs you like are played.

Click [Help Topics](#) to return to the list of topics.

Shows which drive is currently selected.

If you have more than one CD-ROM drive, you can change drives by clicking the down arrow and then clicking the drive from the list.

Provides a space for you to type the name of the artist whose CD is currently in the CD-ROM drive.

Provides a space for you to type the title of the CD currently in the CD-ROM drive.

Shows the order in which tracks will be played. To remove a track from the Play List, click it, and then click Remove.

To play tracks in a different order, click Clear All, and then move tracks from the Available Tracks box to the Play List. You can move the tracks by using the buttons in the dialog box or by dragging them.



Adds the selected track to the Play List.

Removes the selected track from the Play List.

Removes all tracks from the Play List. You can then add tracks in the order you want them to play.

Returns the Play List to the original track order on the CD. The Play List will be the same as the Available Tracks list.

Lists the tracks on the CD currently in the CD-ROM drive. To change the order in which tracks play, select tracks from this list and move them to the Play List.

Provides a space for you to type the name of the track. After you type the name and click Set Name, this track appears in the Available Tracks box and the Play List.

Stores the title you typed in the Tracks box. The title will appear in the Available Tracks box and the Play List.

Specifies that the current CD stops playing when you close CD Player.



Saves any changes you made to CD Player when you close it.

Displays a short description of a toolbar button when you hold your mouse cursor over the button.

Specifies which font size you want to use to display the time-tracking information in the CD Player window.

Specifies the amount of time you want between tracks.
