### 1.2 preface

VLabTV is one of the first CyberGraphX projects I have written. It is comparable to EGSTV but does not need EGS. You need at least a VLab frame grabber and CyberGraphX together with a graphics board. Then you are capable of digitizing video frames on a 8/15/16/24 bit intuition environment. (Have a look at vlabtvpref.jpg).

As I've already said, it's my first CyberGraphX project and it is a freebie. I don't know if I continue my work on this project, it depends on your feedback.

## 1.3 features

- Grab VLab images and display them in a 8/15/16/24 bit intuition environment.
- 8/15/16/24 bit preview monitor
- grabbed images can be saved as simple iff files.

## 1.4 requirements

This software is of use only if you are running Kickstart 3.0+, have a 68020+ and CyberGraphX. A VLab frame grabber is mandatory, of course.

What is CyberGraphX ?

-----

The CyberGraphX system was designed to define an independant graphics standard for graphics boards. We also wanted to continue our development of workbench emulations. We could include all our knowledge of about 3 years of gfx board software development (wb-emulation of visiona, domino, picasso and now the cybervision64).

CyberGraphX is based on hardware dependant monitor drivers and hardware independant libraries. This has some advantages: Bug fixes in the workbench emulation or speed optimizations is of benefit for ALL gfx boards that are supported by the CyberGraphX system. There is no third like XpERT or Village-Tronic inbetween developers and users. That guarantees bug fixes and continued development of the software in the future.

CyberGraphX allows using of 15/16/24 screens independant of the used color model. You are able to use the cybergraphics.library functions to modify this screens. Using graphics.library functions is currently not possible but this may change in one of the next releases.

## 1.5 installation

To use VLabTV you just have to click on the VLabTV icon.

## 1.6 tooltypes

Tooltype descriptions

There are some supported tooltype parameters:

NOMSCRWIDTH

The nominal screen width your vlabtv screen should have.

NOMSCRHEIGHT

The nominal screen height your vlabtv screen should have

SCRDEPTH

The screen depth your screen should have. 8 is minimum

---

**GRAB\_X**

Horizontal startposition of the grabbed image.

**GRAB\_Y**

Vertical startposition of the grabbed image.

**GRAB\_WIDTH**

Width of the grabbed image

**GRAB\_HEIGHT**

Height of the grabbed image

**GRAB\_INPUT**

Input channel which is to be used.

**GRAB\_VTR**

if GRAB\_VTR=YES, grab source is VTR by default

**GRAB\_LACE**

If GRAB\_LACE=YES, images are grabbed interlaced by default

**GRAB\_MODE**

if GRAB\_MODE=PAL, then images are grabbed in PAL mode, NTSC otherwise

**PUBSCREEN**

8-24 bit pubscreen which VLabTV should be opened on (see preview picture)  
This only works with cybergraphics 40.41 and higher.

**FASTYUV2RGB**

If FASTYUV2RGB=YES, then a custom YUV to RGB conversion routine is used for the monitor color preview.

**SETTINGS**

With the SETTINGS tooltype you can specify a different preferences file for VLabTV, default is "PROGDIR:VLabTV.prefs"

**NEXTFRAMEDELAY**

Set NEXTFRAMEDELAY to a valid number in milliseconds to reduce cpu load while the monitor is activated

**FIXEDPREVIEW**

If FIXEDPREVIEW=YES, VLabTV offers a new greyscale preview monitor (Does not work with VLab par). vlab.library V10 required

**DITHER**

If DITHER=FLOYD, VLabTV uses Floyd dithering for 8 bit previews instead of ordered dithering which leads to slower rendering speeds but often better results.

## 1.13 history

Revision V0.14

-----

- VLabTV does not crash anymore when started in monitor pause mode and quitted in pause mode
- the tooltype FASTYUV2RGB is now available as gui option on the monitor options page

Revision V0.13

-----

- new option "scalable window" for all grab projects. You now are able to choose between scalable and zoomable windows. Two new gadgets have been added for zoomable windows in all grab projects when in non scalable mode.
  - channel, scansize, scanposition can now be set seperately

- for preview and scan
- option window is now split into two pages for monitor and scan options

#### Revision V0.12

-----

- added new tooltype NEXTFRAMEDELAY=(number in milliseconds) to reduce cpu load while the monitor is activated
- new tooltype FIXEDPREVIEW=(YES|NO) which offers a new greyscale preview monitor when enabled. (Does not work with VLab par)
- added tooltype DITHER=FLOYD/ORDERED
- The proportional gadgets around a grab window are not available anymore when in scaled mode
- The currently active project now has a border around its image
- This version of of VLabTV comes with vlab.library 10.0 which fixes an annoying bug with VLab YC (The monitor froze sometimes without obvious reasons) and offers some new monitor functions
- saved pictures now get an aspect ratio of 10:9 instead of 4:3 which is more suitable for PAL format images
- removed some annoying debug output left in the 0.10 release
- prop sliders are not available anymore when monitor is in scaled mode
- The monitor preview is a separate task now and works asynchronously from the main program
- VLabTV works on 256 colours screen now, too. Grab projects get a ordered dither in these modes.
- inputchannel is saved with options now, too
