

GENie Navigator Fix

As you have most noticed by now, GENie Navigator will no longer work on the reconfigured GENie bulletin board. You will be unable to use the menu commands that allow you to go directly to the new file listings or to the file download section.

Since I have found it convenient to use these commands, I reconfigured the GENie Navigator files and added some necessary procedures to accomplish the ability to use all the menu commands under the new GENie configuration.

In this file you will find seven text files which, after you have changed the file paths to match those on your machine, you will be able to compile into White Knight procedure files which will make the GENie Navigator menus completely operative. These files are:

FILES - Reconfigured from the original GENie Navigator. Replace your existing FILES.PROC with a procedure file compiled from this text file.

FDWNLOAD - Needed to go to the Freesoft download area.

FNEWFILE - Needed to go to the Freesoft new file listing.

MDWNLOAD - Needed to go to the Macintosh download area.

MNEWFILE - Needed to go to the Macintosh new file listing.

PDWNLOAD - Needed to go to the Mac Pro download area.

PNEWFILE - Needed to go to the Mac Pro new file listing.

Each of these text files should be compiled into White Knight procedure files and placed in the same folder. MAKE SURE YOUR FILE PATHS ARE CORRECT!

You may wonder why each of these procedure files returns to the TOP. I found that this was the only to avoid having to manually add a return when going from a new file listing to a download in the same roundtable or vice versa. I agree that it is not very elegant, but I couldn't find an easier method. If you do, let me know by leaving mail for BRUBUR.
