Chuck, to get SuperLaserSpooler to work with MultiFinder, you need to launch SLS from the Finder, then launch MF by the Option-Command Double Click method.

Or, To get MultiFinder to chain from SLS, you need to change MF to a type "APPL" in ResEdit. Quit, reboot, Chain to MF. Then, open ResEdit, and change the MF type back to "ZSYS" and you'll be fine.

If you want MF to open with all your applications and DA's up, select that option while in the MultiFinder environment. Then, go to the System Folder and change the FinderStartup to any other name. Go to SLS and make it the Startup Application in the Finder only, then go back to the System Folder and change FinderStartup back to the original name. Now reboot and SLS should boot first, then chain to MF, and then MF should open all your DA's and applications as you asked it to.
