TESample is an example application that demonstrates how to initialize the commonly used toolbox managers, operate successfully under MultiFinder, handle desk accessories and create, grow, and zoom windows. The fundamental TextEdit toolbox calls and TextEdit autoscroll are demonstrated. It also shows how to create and maintain scrollbar controls.

It does not by any means demonstrate all the techniques you need for a large application. In particular, Sample does not cover exception handling, multiple windows/documents, sophisticated memory management, printing, or undo. All of these are vital parts of a normal full-sized application.

This application is an example of the form of a Macintosh application; it is NOT a template. It is NOT intended to be used as a foundation for the next world-class, best-selling, 600K application. A stick figure drawing of the human body may be a good example of the form for a painting, but that does not mean it should be used as the basis for the next Mona Lisa.

We recommend that you review this program or Sample before beginning a new application. Sample is a simple app. which doesn't use TextEdit or the Control Manager.
