

MiniBBS v 1.1

MiniBBS permits your MAC to send files and to receive files and messages unattended. It creates a file called Activity Log that contains a record of all call activity, as well as the text of any messages sent to you. It will receive files using any protocol supported by MicroPhone II, and permits files to be sent in either XModem or XModem MacBinary formats.

How to Use MiniBBS

1. Files Included

This file contains 4 MicroPhone II scripts:

- **MiniBBS**
- **MiniBBS Sends File**
- **MiniBBS Receives File**
- **MiniBBS Receives Message**

2. Importing MiniBBS into MicroPhone II

To import these scripts into MicroPhone II, take the following steps:

- Enter MicroPhone.
- Select Import Scripts from the Scripts pull-down menu.
- After importing all 4 scripts into MicroPhone, save the settings file.

3. Activating MiniBBS from Within MicroPhone II

MiniBBS will now appear on the Scripts pull-down menu. To use **MiniBBS**, just select **MiniBBS** from the Scripts pull-down menu.

4. Preparing MiniBBS to Send Files of Your Choice to Callers

MiniBBS is fairly limited in its support for file transfer. If someone asks to receive files from you, they will be sent all the files you have designated for transfer, whether they want

them all or not.

To set up **MiniBBS** to transfer files to callers who request files:

- Select Modify Script from the Scripts menu, then choose the script **MiniBBS** for modification
- Change the 0 in line 1 to the number of files you wish to transfer to callers who request files.
- Copy whatever files you want to send into the MicroPhone folder and name them File_1, File_2, File_3, etc. Be sure to include the underline character ('_') between the word 'File' and the number of each file.

That's it!
