

LockVolName 1.1b1 is a freeware system extension that prevents users from changing the name of volumes in the Finder.

To install **LockVolName**, edit the name your volumes to what you want them to be and then place **LockVolName** in your System Folder (Extensions folder in System 7) and reboot. After this point, the name of any mounted volumes will no longer be editable in the Finder. **LockVolName** works by making every editing action on a volume name the equivalent of typing an up arrow. As a result, when an editing action, such as typing, cutting, pasting, or deleting is performed on the name, the insertion point will be forced to the beginning of the name and will begin blinking as if the user had typed an up arrow. Any further editing action on the name will simply reiterate the process. Of course, a user may remove the **LockVolName** from the System Folder to circumvent this restriction. As a result, you may want to invest in a shareware or commercial product to accommodate this problem.

Unlike most other system extensions, **LockVolName** cannot not be bypassed at startup by holding down the shift key.
