

Thanks for taking the time to explore a little-known feature of MacWrite III!

This paragraph starts out above the party hat picture. You'll format it so it appears beside the hat graphic when printed. (You won't see it on the screen.) First of all, select everything from the start of this paragraph up to and including the party hat. Don't include the first and last paragraphs. Good, now choose Paragraph... from the Format menu. Change the units for line spacing from lines to points. Then click Ok. This keeps MacWrite II from automatically adjusting the line spacing for the big graphic. The picture will be clipped so you only see a sliver of the bottom of it. Now select this paragraph only (not the picture), and reset the left margin to 3.5 inches. When you print, the picture will show completely, and this paragraph will be to the right of it. If you prefer the text on the left, then click on the part of the hat picture you can see, and set the left margin to 5 inches. Then select this paragraph and set the left margin to 1 inch and the right margin to 4.5 inches. You'll need to experiment and estimate the best settings for your particular picture.
