Just a note to tell you about the clip art samples included with this review. Please feel free to choose what ever you like or will better fit from the disks I gave you. There is some terrific stuff there. The image I chose for the Graphics is a Food Collage on Disk A/Multigraphics/item a.; the image for Business is a World Globe on Disk D/Travel/item d.; and I chose two for illustrating Accents and Borders. The first is a horizontally oriented certificate frame (you might put some of the text inside the frame) on Disk A, Frames Horz./item c.; and the other is a strip of Christmas symbols from Disk E, Symbols C-Z/item a.

I will photocopy the Pictorial Indexes for these three so you can see what is where. Would you like copies of the manuals as well? They contain mainly ideas for use of the art. When I register the Accents and Borders, 3G Graphics will send a color borders and symbols disk and I will get a copy of that for you, too.
