

# Adobe® InCopy® CS Tryout Version ReadMe

Thank you for evaluating Adobe InCopy CS software with this fully functional 30 day tryout version. The 30 day evaluation period starts from when you first launch the application. You will be able to use the full functionality of InCopy CS during this 30 day evaluation period.

## Support

## If you decide to purchase InCopy CS

If after the evaluation period, you purchase InCopy CS, please do the following to ensure optimal performance:

- Uninstall the tryout version before installing the retail version of InCopy CS. If you accidentally install the retail version without first un-installing the tryout version, we strongly recommend un-installing both versions and then re-installing the retail version.
- On Mac OS X, launch the retail application for the first time by double-clicking the application icon, and not by double-clicking an InCopy document. After the first launch, you can also launch the application by double-clicking on InCopy document icons.

## Known issues

The tryout version can be installed on systems which have InCopy 2.0.1 or earlier versions installed, but it cannot be installed on systems which have InCopy CS retail version installed.

If you launch InCopy CS on Mac OS X for the first time by double-clicking an InCopy document icon, you may see the error "There is no default application specified to open the document". If this occurs, you should click OK in the error dialog and launch InCopy CS by double-clicking on the application icon. This step correctly registers the application in the Mac OS X Finder database. From then on, you can double-click InCopy document icons to launch the application and open the documents.
