

If you have WordPerfect for the Macintosh, you can convert this WordPerfect/PC 5.0 using the utility included on your disks. Notice the formatting from the PC document:

Bold, underline, *italic*, ~~strikeout~~, even ^{super}script and _{sub}script text remain after conversion.

There are two main ways of opening this document on your Macintosh with AccessPC.

Open the document with a Macintosh application which can read WordPerfect files. This would be done by mapping the extension of this file to the application which can read WordPerfect files.

The other method of opening the file is using the translators provided with AccessPC. To do this, ensure the extension of this file is not mapped to an application by AccessPC. Then double click on the file and you will be provided with a list of translation options. Select one of these options and the file will be converted and the application opened.
