Allows you to navigate across schedules, searches and bookmarks.

Contains all the searches and search results. Right click to access a menu to view search properties, perform a new search or to delete an existing search or set of search results. Searches may be dragged and dropped onto schedules to initiate the scheduling of a search.

Contains a single search, a set of search results, or an intermediate folder. Right click to access a menu to view search properties, perform a new search or to delete an existing search or set of search results. Searches may be dragged and dropped onto schedules to initiate the scheduling of a search.

Contains all the schedules. Right click to access a menu to view schedule properties, create a new schedule or to delete an existing schedule. Searches may be dragged and dropped onto schedules to initiate the scheduling of a search. Bookmarks may be dragged and dropped onto schedules to initiate the scheduling of a monitoring activity.

Contains a single schedule or an intermediate folder. Right click to access a menu to view schedule properties, create a new schedule or to delete an existing schedule. Searches may be dragged and dropped onto schedules to initiate the scheduling of a search. Bookmarks may be dragged and dropped onto schedules to initiate the scheduling of a monitoring activity.

Contains all the bookmarks. Right click to access a menu to view bookmark properties, create a new folder or to delete an existing set of bookmarks. Bookmarks may be dragged and dropped onto schedules to initiate the scheduling of a monitoring activity.

Contains a single set of bookmarks or an intermediate folder. Right click to access a menu to view bookmark properties, create a new folder or to delete an existing set of bookmarks. Bookmarks may be dragged and dropped onto schedules to initiate the scheduling of a monitoring activity.

Lists the contents of the folder opened in the tree view. Items may be sorted according to each of the column entries. Icons provide the status of items associated with scheduled activities. Individual or sets of items may be dragged and dropped onto schedules to activate scheduled monitoring or searching. Right clicking on items to access a menu to view properties, access a local copy or the results of monitoring, or to delete the item.

This icon indicates that the site associated with this item has xSpeed enabled on their server.

This icon indicates that the item is being monitored to detect changes.

This icon indicates that a local copy exists for this item.

This icon indicates that a change to this item has been detected as a result of monitoring.

Enables sorting of the list by title.

Enables sorting of the list by time of next occurrence.

Enables sorting of the list by the time the activity was last ran.

Enables sorting of the list by the time the item was last modified.

Enables sorting of the list by the Internet address of the item.

Enables sorting of the list by the relevancy rank of the item.

Enables sorting of the list by the source of the item.

Lists the properties associated with the highlighted item.

Provides a space for you to enter the search query.

Lists the places that may be searched. Click on the check box to select areas of interest.

Lists the search engines available for searching on the WWW. Click on the check box to select the desired search engine(s).

Specifies the name of the search and the folder where it will be saved. You may enter the desired path and name directly or use the Browse button to navigate to the folder of interest.

Click this to select where to save the search and to specify the search name.

Starts the search, unless it is scheduled for a later date.

Click this to schedule the search for a later time.

Cancel the specification of a search and close the dialog, or stop an interactive search.

Lists the available schedules. If associated with the specification of an activity, clicking on a schedule may assign the schedule to the activity or de-assign the schedule from the activity. Highlighted a schedule will display the schedule's properties.

Creates a new user-defined schedule. The new schedule will be added to the list of available schedules.

Suspends an active schedule and all of its related activities or resumes a suspended schedule.

Permanently deletes the selected schedule and halts all the activities associated with the schedule.

Displays the next scheduled occurrence associated with the highlighted schedule.

Displays the properties of the highlighted schedule. Changes made to these properties will be saved if another schedule is chosen or if OK is pressed.

Provides a space for you to define the date that the highlighted schedule should take effect.

Provides a space for you to define the time that the highlighted schedule should start.

Click this to save changes to the schedule shown.

Closes this dialog box without saving the changes to the last schedule.

Provides a space to enter the maximum number of hits to receive from each search engine site.

Provides a space to enter the maximum time to spend gathering results from each search engine site.

Closes this dialog box and saves any changes you have made.

Provides a space for you to enter the name desired for the search.

Provides an area for you to enter the folder in which to store the search.

Provides a list of the bookmarks found based on your search query. Double-clicking on a bookmark will display it within your browser.

Permits sorting of the results by path. Double-clicking on the entry will display the item within the browser.

Provides an area to specify the bookmark folder.

Provides you with a way to navigate the bookmark folders to select a desired folder.

Closes this dialog box and saves any changes you have made.
