

Help for Your Installation Process

At the Installation Options dialog box, you are directed, step-by-step, through individual preferences for Functional Options for Skill Builder courses, Mastery Test Feedback options, Bookmark and Score options and the Change Directory options.

Skill Builder Functional Options

Time Out Feature - If there is no user interaction with the course for a period of 50 seconds, the student is prompted to move forward.

Automatic Page Forward Feature - Causes the course to automatically move to the next page when audio completes. When student interaction is required, the course will pause and wait for student interaction.

Mastery Test Feedback Options

Full - Displays the *Correct* response after each question is answered.

Partial - Displays feedback of either *Correct* or *Incorrect* after each response.

None - Displays *no* feedback during the entire test.

Bookmark and Score Options

Bookmark and Score Tracking - Tracks scores and provides bookmarking for the course.

If you choose to utilize the Bookmark and Score Tracking, a file will be stored on your hard drive containing that information. To modify the path click on the Change Directory [Change Directory Options](#) button.

Change Directory Options

To change the Destination Directory for installing course files type a complete destination path in the Path box and choose the OK button. You may also select the destination directory using the Directories box. The Directories box displays a list of available directories and it updates the Path box as directories are selected.

If the directory is on a different drive, select the drive from the Drives box. All directories for that drive will then appear in the Directories box.

If the directory does not exist, select the drive and directory you want in the Path and add the subdirectory name in the Path box. Simply type it in at the end of the Path.
