I am sending the attached files at Brad's request. I have attached .jpg files showing the front and back of our box (for fun) and I've attached the actual program so you can install it, run it, and evaluate how SafeNet can help you greatly increase sales to parents who have the internet. SafeNet sells for \$29.95. We can either set you up as a reseller buying the program for \$19.95 and selling for \$29.95 and after 6 uses the customer will still have to call us to get his registration number to unlock the program. Or, you can distribute the program free on every CD and use it to help promote the CD set but after they install it and use it 6 times (about 6 to 12 weeks of usable life) then they would call us and pay us \$29.95 to unlock it forever. We will try to be creative in working to your marketing model.

SafeNet(sm) - Purpose and Benefits:

Attached is the Setup.exe file. Everything you need to run the latest version of SafeNet on your PC(s). SafeNet(sm) is the first graphic internet activity monitor so you can stand at the shoulder of your children or employees and view what they've seen on the internet. Monitor while you're away. View what they saw when you return. When they know you're watching, the internet becomes safer than the public library. Employee productivity goes up!

Providing SafeNet to your customers will help you double all internet related software and hardware sales because of the large group that are hesitating to get on-line because of this very problem, "What will my children or employees do on the internet when I'm not watching?"

We look forward to being a valued asset in your internet software and hardware sales efforts.

Capturing and Installing SafeNet:

Copy the attached setup.exe file to your A: drive, onto a floppy. You then have exactly what we sell in stores, on the floppy. The program is fully functional for six (6) demo runs. You can then either "un-install" or phone to register the program, pay, and get a password to continue using SafeNet (sm).

To install just click on START then on RUN and type a:\setup.exe - then press ENTER.

To uninstall just click on START, then on Programs, then on SafeNet, then on Uninstall.

After installing SafeNet on your PC you can run it by clicking on the new desk-top eye-con. You will need to enter the USER-ID: SUPER and the password: SUPER This will get you into the program, fully functional. Since I am not there to guide you through using the program, you may want to go into the Help? area and read a bit before entering the SUPER password and user-id.

This demo should be run on a stand alone PC with access to the internet. IF the PC you install SafeNet on is connected to a NETWORK of PC's then you must;

1. click on the "magnifying glass" icon to start a new search,
2. then select the drive and directory designated for your network's internet browser cache files.

SafeNet will show graphic files on all drives attached to the Network but this may become more of a drain, or grid-lock, rather than an advantage, unless you know exactly which drive and directory you want to scan for graphic images. SafeNet can also be used to scan CD-ROM's for usable graphic images and store them to disk. SafeNet-NT will be available later this year to enhance further our capabilities for networked PC's.

After you've paid for and gotten the password that will unlock SafeNet for good, you may want to go into the HELP text and learn how to change your USER-ID and PASSWORD so that only authorized management know the password and user-id to get in.

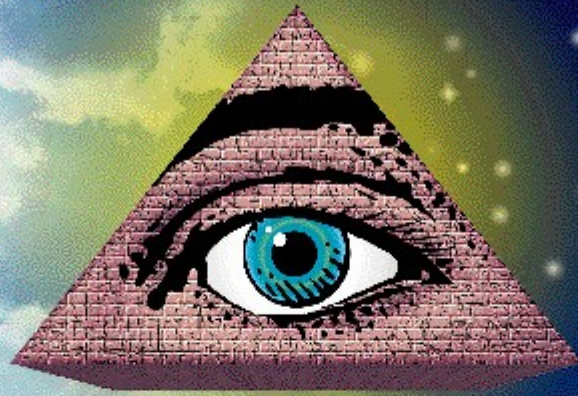
