

Rules For Entering Script

The following is a sample of a typical script:

15b 22b 22b 31B

Here are the main rules concerning the entry of such a Script.

1. Only four letters are allowed in the script. They include the following:

b : A Single Black Piece

w : A Single White Piece

B : A Kinged Black Piece

W : A Kinged White Piece

2. The Numbers 1 to 32 representing the Board Indexes are valid characters. Note that numbers 1 right up to 9 must be represented by a two digit number. This is done by preceeding the number with a zero. Thus 9 becomes 09, 8 becomes 08 & so forth.

3. Any number of spaces can appear between a letter to be followed by a number. No spaces can appear in between two numbers or between a number to be followed by a letter. The script is just a series

of two numbers & a letter followed by one or more spaces.

4. In the example given above, a black piece on square 15 is going to make a double jump. The piece jumps from square 15 to square 22 to square 31. The number 22 must be entered twice because this is a sequence of two moves for the black player. This must be done for every such instance in the script. Also, in this example the black piece is kinged & this is represented by 31B.
