

Welcome to the iSync 1.4 for Mac OS X Installer

iSync 1.4 for Mac OS X is synchronization software that helps you manage your Address Book contacts and iCal calendar and to-do information on your Mac OS computers and other devices (such as an iSync-compatible mobile phone, Palm OS device, or iPod). If you have a .Mac account, you can use iSync to synchronize your contacts, calendars, and Safari bookmarks across multiple computers using the Internet. With a .Mac account, you can access most of this information from any computer using a web browser.

You must install iCal 1.5.1 or later prior to installing iSync 1.4. To download iCal, run Software Update or visit www.apple.com/ical.

If you are using Mac OS X version 10.3 and plan to synchronize a Bluetooth mobile phone, you need to have Bluetooth version 1.5 or later installed. To download it, use Software Update (in System Preferences). If you have an earlier version of Mac OS X, visit www.apple.com/isync to download the appropriate Bluetooth version.

This installer guides you through the steps necessary to install iSync 1.4 for Mac OS X. To get started, click Continue.
