




- Microsoft Windows 95 operating system or later, Microsoft Windows NT® Workstation operating system version 3.51 Service Pack 5 or later, or Microsoft Windows NT Workstation 4.0 Service Pack 2 or later (will not run on earlier versions)
- 12 MB of memory for use on Windows 95; 16 MB for Windows NT Workstation
- 20–40 MB of available hard-disk space required; 30 MB required for typical installation, depending upon configuration
- CD-ROM drive
- VGA or higher-resolution video adapter (Super VGA, 256-color recommended)
- Microsoft Mouse, Microsoft IntelliMouse™, or compatible pointing device
- Leading Windows-compatible network and MAPI-compliant mail systems, or a Web server and Web browser, are required for workgroup functionality


