TrueType® to GEM Font Converter

Thank you for registering TTGEM. This software converts Windows™ TrueType® fonts to GEM fonts used by MS-DOS graphics libraries as well as by other applications. Fonts created by this program have only been tested with the Genus Microprogramming graphics toolkit and so they may or may not work with any other application (although they should).

New for Version 2.0

Version 2.0 allows you to select which characters you wish to include in the created GEM font, allowing you to significantly reduce the amount of memory required. Refer to the program's on-line help for information.

New for Version 2.1 and 2.2

These versions include various bug fixes.

Notes

If you are converting the Windows™ **Symbol** font, make sure that there is only one font with the name Symbol and that it is a TrueType® font. You may have a non-TrueType® font also named **Symbol** and this font will conflict with the TrueType® font, preventing you from converting it at certain point sizes. Since you probably do not need the older, non-TrueType® font, the easiest thing to do is to remove it. To do this, use the Fonts applet within the Windows™ Control Panel.
