How to install Mesa

Mesa is supplied as a disk image - Mesa3.dmg.

After you have downloaded Mesa3.dmg, copy the Mesa.app application to the location on your hard disk where you'd like it to be kept - this should be the Applications directory - and run Mesa from that location. (NB - If the disk image doesn't open automatically, use the Disk Copy Utility to start it).

NOTE: Do not run Mesa from the Mesa3 disk image. Mesa will work fine, but you may find that even after you quit Mesa you are unable to Eject the disk image. If this happens to you, rebooting your computer will solve the problem.

The Mesa3 disk image contains the following files:

Mesa3.app - the Mesa spreadsheet application including online Help
README.rtf - this file of useful instructions and release notes
RELEASENOTES.rtf - specific enhancements/fixes in this release
Mesa3.LicenseAgreement - terms and conditions for using Mesa

Licensing

Mesa is supplied in Demo Mode, in which workbooks are restricted to a 20 x 20 size and the word 'Demo' appears on all printouts. Other functionality is the same as in the full version.
