

Calindock version 1.2.0

About Calindock

Calindock is a Mac OS X dockling that displays a monthly or daily calendar in the Dock. Calindock is currently being released as freeware!

A Word About Docklings

Docklings are small! Completely magnified or at full size they are only 128 x 128 pixels. That's not a lot of room for displaying something with as much info as a monthly calendar. If you don't use the Dock's magnification feature or don't have your Dock size set somewhere near "Large" Calindock may not currently be a terribly useful dockling for you!

Instructions

To use Calindock, either double click the "Calindock.dock" icon or simply drag the "Calindock.dock" icon to the Dock and drop it where you'd like it to appear. By default Calindock displays the current month. The current day will be highlighted. Clicking the Calindock dockling will display a menu that enables you to move forward and back in time through the calendar. You can always return to the current month by simply selecting "Current Month" from this menu.

There are a couple of other menu options. The "Calendar Format" menu option allows you to toggle between either a monthly or daily calendar. Use the "Week Begins" option to change the starting day for your week to either Sunday or Monday. Note that this option and the ability to change dates are not available while using the daily calendar format.

Should the date on your computer change, Calindock updates itself to reflect the new date. Please note that it may take a few seconds for Calindock to display the change!

- The API's used to create this dockling are unsupported by Apple! The next time Apple releases an update for Mac OS X, there is a chance that Calindock may not function properly. **THIS IS NOT**

APPLE'S FAULT OR PROBLEM!

- If you are running Mac OS X version 10.0.4 you will likely get an error window when Calindock starts up stating that the dockling may not function properly. **THIS IS TO BE EXPECTED!** This is built in to Brian Webster's dockling template. Any dockling created this template will show this same error window. You should only see this error once. Until someone lets me know how to update a dockling icon in the Dock using Apple's unpublished dockling API, I will continue to use Brian's excellent dockling template.
