## **QuicKeys automates design and production**

QuicKeys is a macro-editor that allows you to set up hotkey or toolbar triggers for all the complex, multi-step tasks you perform on your Mac. Shortcuts can be created on the fly, in any application. Best of all, you don’t have to know scripting commands or programming language.

Building sequences is as easy as telling QuicKeys to “record” your actions once and then play them back on demand. Plus, a powerful batch processor lets you run your shortcuts on an unlimited number of files automatically with a keystroke. Let QuicKeys do all that repetitive, wrist-wrenching mouse work for you and free up your creative side.

“What I love about version 3.5 is the batch processor.

There are so many times when I have to perform the same series of actions on multiple documents, like resizing a bunch of scanned photos in Photoshop. This is where the batch processor is a godsend.”



## Make your system work the way you do

QuicKeys 3.5 ships with keysets for Illustrator, PageMaker, Photoshop and other graphic design software, giving you instant functionality as soon as you install. Toolbars and floating palettes put your customized commands at your fingertips, and new click-and-go palettes appear with a keystroke to perform certain tasks and then disappear, saving screen real estate.

Plus, you can make the same hotkey trigger the same action across all your applications. In other words, using QuicKeys command-W could close any window, whether it be in Photoshop, Illustrator, PageMaker, whatever. In a nutshell, QuicKeys gives you the power to make your computer behave exactly as you want it to.

## Good help is hard to find

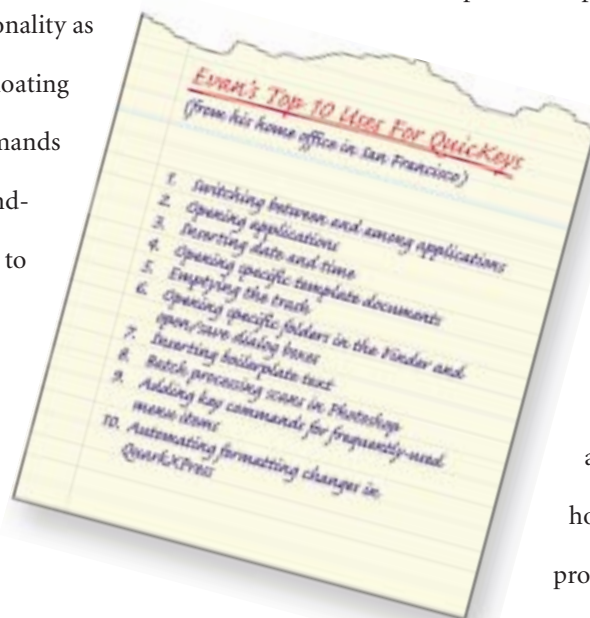
While most of Deerfield's design day is spent in Photoshop, Illustrator and QuarkXPress, where QuicKeys sequences automate his every move, he has also turned QuicKeys into a trusty administrative assistant. Hotkey triggers bring up fax cover sheets pre-addressed to different clients and stamped

with boilerplate text. Like a good secretary, QuicKeys always knows where to find the right file. QuicKeys sequences launch specific templates and documents customized for different clients, saving a lot of time spent digging around in dialog boxes. QuicKeys even automates Deerfield's billing system. Using QuicKeys in conjunction with FileMaker Pro, Deerfield is able to automatically record date and time, how long he worked on a particular project and the total billable hours.

"QuicKeys does just about everything around here except run to the fridge for another can of Coke," Deerfield jokes. "Seriously, it's not an application that I would want to try to live without. With it, I'm more productive, more organized and more profitable."
