Frequently Asked Questions

How do you change the Utility pattern?

Using System 7.5.x or System 7.6.x:

- 1) Open the Desktop Patterns control panel
- 2) Choose the pattern you want to use as the Utility Pattern
- 3) Hold down the Option key, the "Set Desktop Pattern" button will change to "Set Utilities Pattern"
- 4) Click on the "Set Utilities Pattern" button

If you are a MacOS 8.0 user, and you still have the System 7.5.x or 7.6.x Desktop Patterns control panel, this technique will still work, although it is unsupported by Apple.
