

How to use Waves processors in demo mode

Please note: Waves Plug-ins will not run in demo mode under AudioSuite.

How to run plugins in demo mode

First, launch the installer and install all the plug-ins.
On Bias Peak, the process is disabled for demo, of course.

To use as a demo:

- 1-Launch Peak.
- 2-Select a region of audio you want to preview.
- 3-Select a Waves plug-in from Peak's plug-in menu bar (see your program's manual for specific instructions).
- 4-Click the Preview button in the plug-in window .
- 5-Change the values to experiment and audition the sound.

Note: There are no "special versions" of the plug-ins for demo use. All "regular" software is dongle-protected (except AudioTrack within AudioSuite, and WaveConvert Pro); therefore, if you don't have a WaveKey dongle, or your WaveKey is not authorized for certain plug-ins, those plug-ins will work as a demo.
