1036 is another very small program simply designed to make host look like it does more than it does. When selected it will tell the user what time it is. If the user is on the local keyboard the modem is not addressed and a delay is built in to make reading easier. An entry is also made in the callerlog that the user needs to buy a watch.

To use 1036 you need only two files. 1036 itself and PATHFILE. Pathfile is nothing new to type 50,51 programs and the one that you may be using will be just fine if you add to the end the path to the callerlog. A sample pathfile is included. I used the pathfile for Quote of the Day and then just added a line.

1036 MUST be on the same volume and in the same folder at Red Ryder Host. Pathfile must also be in the same folder and on the same volume.

This program is short enough that I feel using command 51 with it is safe. It does check for a carrier while online and will go back to the BBS when either the carrier is lost or after it writes to the callerlog. Total duration of the program for an online caller is only about 5 seconds and 10 for a caller from the local keyboard.

This program, its source code and all routine within are placed in the public domain for other Host sysops to use, modify and learn from. Source code is provided in both ZBasic format and ASCII TEXT format.
