This font programme is copyright (C) 1990 Quando. It may be freely redistributed, but may not be sold; it is an adaptation of BIFUR, designed by A.M. Cassandre. The font is bichromatic, and will print as **black + 25% grey (75 lpi / 0 deg)**.

The colours may be controlled by setting the PostScript names /FontColour1 and /FontColour2 in the font directory to the dark and light grey values respectively.

This font is PostScript Type 3, does not use the font cache, and has no UniqueID, and uses "fond" family ID 9998.
