

Introducing NanoNotes!

NanoNotes is a simple text editor, similar to Apple's TeachText, with the following enhancements...

- Supports Styled Text, including COLOR
- Creates Stand-Alone documents
- Runs on all Macintosh Systems (System 6 & 7)
- Built-in option to lock documents
- Undo and Redo Support
- Ultra-small size!

NanoNotes is perfect for distributing ReadMe files! Never fear the dreaded Missing Application message, because every NanoNotes contains its own embedded text editor!

How to use NanoNotes...

- 1) Replace the contents with your text.
- 2) Select 'Save As...' from the File Menu. To prevent further modifications, check the 'Lock and Minimize' option. (This will also reduce file size!)

NanoNotes is Shareware! - \$8

Here's the deal... You may distribute single documents you create with NanoNotes for free. However, to distribute more than 100 copies of your document you must pay the one-time registration fee. If you'd like a disk with the latest version of NanoNotes, and other cool Shareware programs, add \$2.
