

# Artisto+ 2.02<sup>©</sup>

Differences between version 2.02 and earlier versions:

- Artisto now works correctly with FullPaint.
  - Small selections cut from Artisto and pasted into FullPaint or MacPaint now act as if they had been selected with a lasso instead of the rectangle.
  - Fixes a few bugs.
  - Artisto now works on a Max XL.
  - **Double-clicking the selection rectangle tool will select the smallest rectangle that encloses the whole image.**
  - **Moving the document around with the hand tool no longer turns off the current selection.**
  - **Artisto+ works on Macintosh II's and works better with large screens.**
  - **The Artisto window can be resized.**
  - **MacDraw files saved as PICT files can be opened by Artisto+.**
  - **If the the clipboard contains a picture, it can be displayed in the Artisto window.**
  - **Pictures are copied to the clipboard in a fashion that uses less memory than previous versions.**

**Artisto+** is a desk accessory of the "Paint Cutter" variety. Artisto+ allows you to open up a MacPaint document (or MacDraw document saved in PICT format) from inside any program that supports desk accessories and select any portion of the image and copy it into the clipboard.

**Note:** You must have a 512k (or larger) Mac in order to use this desk accessory.

Artisto+ supports two tools: a hand for moving the image around and a selection tool for selecting a portion of the image. The hand works exactly like the hand in MacPaint. It allows you to move around the whole paint image very quickly. Double-click on the hand icon to enter "show page" mode (just like MacPaint). The selection tool works just like it does in MacPaint except that if you drag outside the borders of the Artisto+ window, the image will automatically scroll. Double-click on the selection tool to select the whole image on the document. Use the "Copy" command under the application program's Edit menu or command-C to copy the selected image to the clipboard. You can toggle between the two tools without selecting the other tool by holding down the shift or option key.

Artisto+ puts up its own menu in the menu bar. The menu has four choices: About Artisto+, Open, Show Page, and Show Clipboard. Selecting Open brings up the standard file dialog and allows you to select a MacPaint, FullPaint, or MacDraw (saved

in PICT format) document. The document will be displayed in the Artisto+ window. The Show Page command displays the whole document on the screen (alá MacPaint) and allows you to select which portion is visible on the screen. The Show Clipboard command will display the contents of the clipboard if the clipboard contains a picture. When Artisto+ is first opened, the standard file dialog is displayed. If the clipboard contains a picture, however, the clipboard will be displayed in the Artisto+ window instead.
