

Reader Format Driver

Standard Macintosh™ Text Format

This format driver allows you to open and print text files. You can also select any portion of the text and copy it to the Clipboard. The Search menu can be used to find and select portions of the text.

Notes On Use...

- Each Text document uses an amount of memory approximately equal to its file size plus up to an additional 32K of overhead depending upon how large the document is.
- This is a simple implementation of a text format driver and is limited to reading files less than 32K in size. (About 32000 characters) Files larger than this will have their text truncated when displayed.
- The text search operation is case sensitive. For example, searching the paragraph above for “about”, the format driver would report that “about” was not found. However, searching for “About” would select the word, and if necessary, the format driver would scroll the text to make sure the selected word was visible.
- All the options in the Page Setup and Print dialogs can be used.
- The Font and Size of the text cannot be changed.
- Even though only a vertical scroll bar is available, if the window is hiding part of the text you can click in the window and make a horizontal selection that will scroll the text into view.
