New features and changes since version 1.0

- * Improved HTML **importing**. The **Open...** command is more flexible about opening and correcting files that contain invalid HTML markup. This functionality replaces the **Import Through Filter** command.
- * More intuitive **user interface**
 - **Insert Element** and **Surround** commands combined
 - 'Enter' key now splits elements
 - Backspacing over start-tag joins elements of the same type
 - Surrounds with required elements when you type
- * Supported Netscape and HTML 3.0 **extensions** integrated seamlessly
- * Powerful and easy-to-use **table** editor
- * **Toolbars** for menu commands and inserting HTML elements
- * Improved **URL editor** (including **hotlist** support)
- * **Preferences** editor
- * Point-and-click **link creation**
- * **History** list of last 4 opened files

Known problems

Displaying images

- Images that do not occur on the same line as the start-tag of a block element (for example, a paragraph, blockquote, heading, etc.) may be truncated. This may affect the display of surrounding text. A workaround is to surround these images with a paragraph.
- Sometimes images will be truncated if the document window is small. You should try resizing the window.

Previewing

If you launch Enhanced Mosaic from the **Preview...** command, and another application is running "underneath" HoTMetaL on your screen, then that third application will run "above" HoTMetaL, and below Enhanced Mosaic.

Running under OS/2 Warp

We recommend running under OS/2 **3.0** Warp rather than 2.1.
