System requirements to view the Animation Series

In order to view the Shockwave files from the PhotoDisc Animation Series Sneak Peek CD you will need Netscape 2.02, or higher and Internet Explorer 3.0, Shockwave Plug-In and a CD-ROM drive. A sound card is required for Shockwave files with sound.

After the Plug-In is installed, Shockwave files can be played within HTML documents. Please see the Shockwave Installer and the How to view the Shockwave and Animated GIFs. Print them out for easy reference.

The platforms compatible with Shockwave are Macintosh Power PC, 68K, Windows 3.1, Windows 95, and Windows NT version 3.5.1.

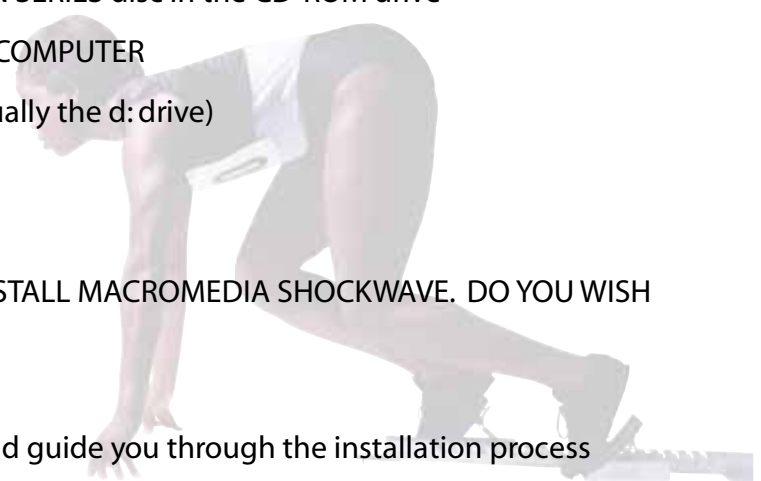

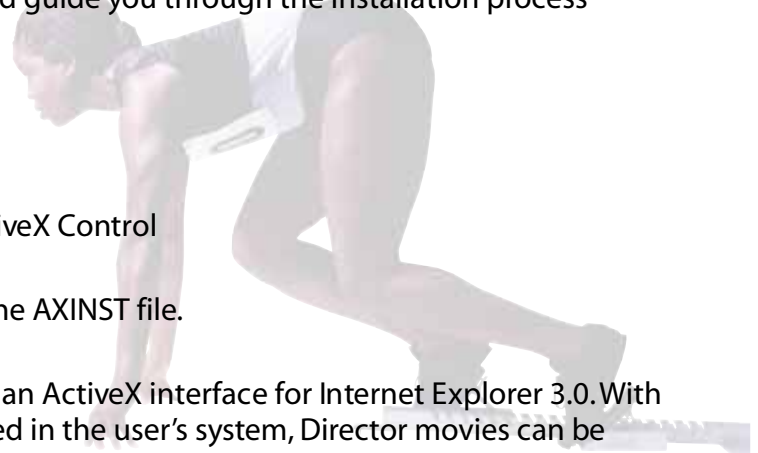

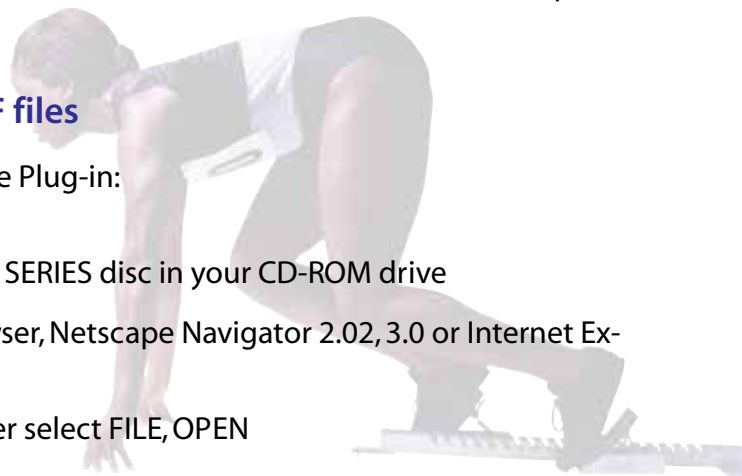
Installation of Shockwave's ActiveX Control is automatic under Internet Explorer 3.0. When it first comes across an HTML page with an object tag that references Shockwave, Internet Explorer 3.0 asks the user for permission to download the Shockwave control. If the user approves, it downloads and installs the control.

If the Shockwave Director ActiveX control is not installed in Internet Explorer 3.0, you may download it from Macromedia's website (www.macromedia.com). To download and install the Shockwave for ActiveX control, launch Internet Explorer 3.0 and go to Macromedia's website (www.macromedia.com). Click on the Shockwave hypertext link, then click on the Download Shockwave hypertext link. Click on the get Shockwave for ActiveX hypertext link. This will automatically install the Shockwave ActiveX control into Internet Explorer 3.0

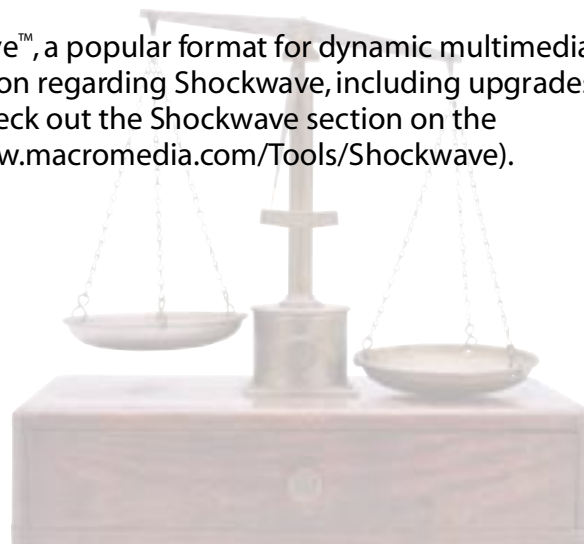



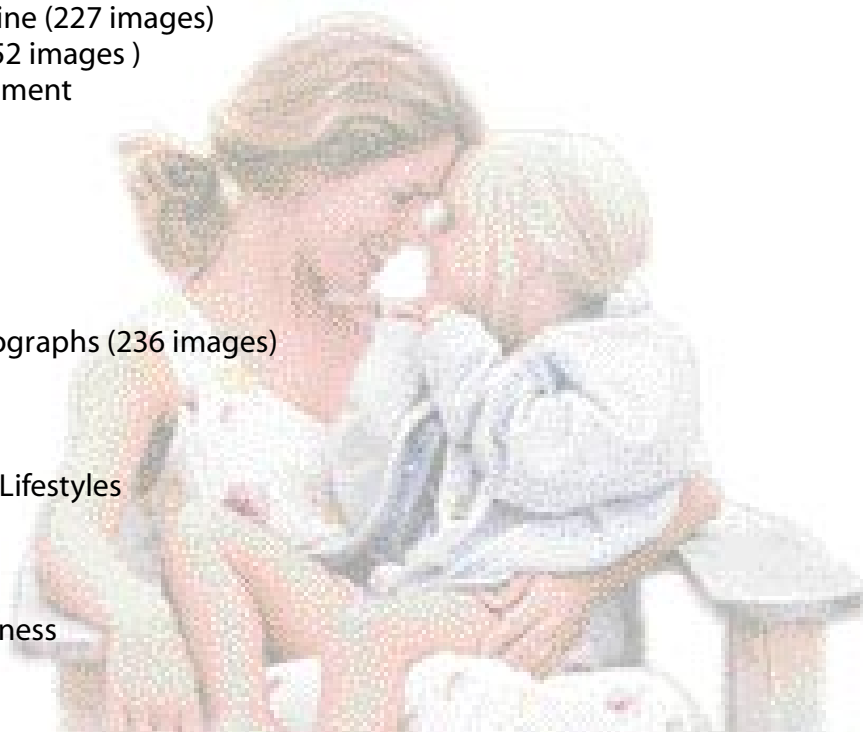
